Hervey Bay Hospital 'Name the Crane'

Terms and Conditions

By entering the 'Name the Crane competition' (the competition), hosted by Wide Bay Hospital and Health Service (WBHHS), all entrants indicate their agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions.

- 1. The purpose of the competition is to name the crane for the Hervey Bay Hospital Expansion project.
- 2. Entries are open to primary-school aged children within the Fraser Coast Regional Council local government area.
- 3. Entries must be submitted by Sunday, 9 March 2025. After this time, no further entries to the competition will be accepted.
- 4. No responsibility can be accepted for entries not received by the due date for any reason.
- 5. A selection panel, consisting of WBHHS, consumer and contractor representatives, will shortlist the top four entries, which will be published online for public voting. The entry with the most votes will be the winner.
- 6. Names will be judged on creativity, originality, and relevance to the crane's purpose, the hospital's expansion, and its connection to health, community, and progress.
- 7. The judging panel's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 8. Only one name per student will be accepted. If multiple entries are submitted, only the first one received will be considered.
- 9. Parent/guardian permission and contact details must be provided with each entry.
- 10. Entries that are incomplete, inappropriate, or offensive will be deemed ineligible. Names must not reference businesses, brands, or trademarks, and should avoid political, religious, or other divisive themes.

- 12. Winners will be announced via the WBHHS Facebook page and will be notified by telephone or email within seven business days of voting closing.
- 13. The prize for the winner includes the opportunity to name the crane, have that name displayed on the crane, a gift donated by the managing contractor, and an invitation to attend a crane naming ceremony and photo opportunity. Prizes are not transferable or exchangeable.
- 14. Any personal data submitted with the entry will be used solely in accordance with current *Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act 1998.*
- 15. By participating, entrants agree to have their name, age, school name, crane name and photo published in all media channels, including social media, if they are selected as the winner.
- 16. There is no entry fee and no purchase necessary to enter the competition.
- 17. Any transport costs or ancillary costs to collect a prize, attend a site tour or photo opportunity at Hervey Bay Hospital are the winner's responsibility.
